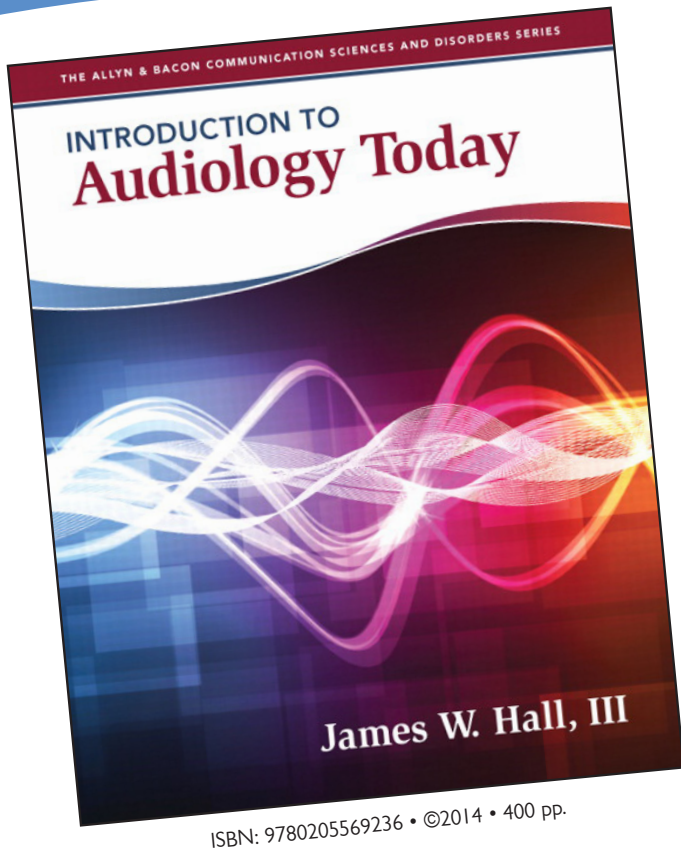


Introduction to Audiology Today
